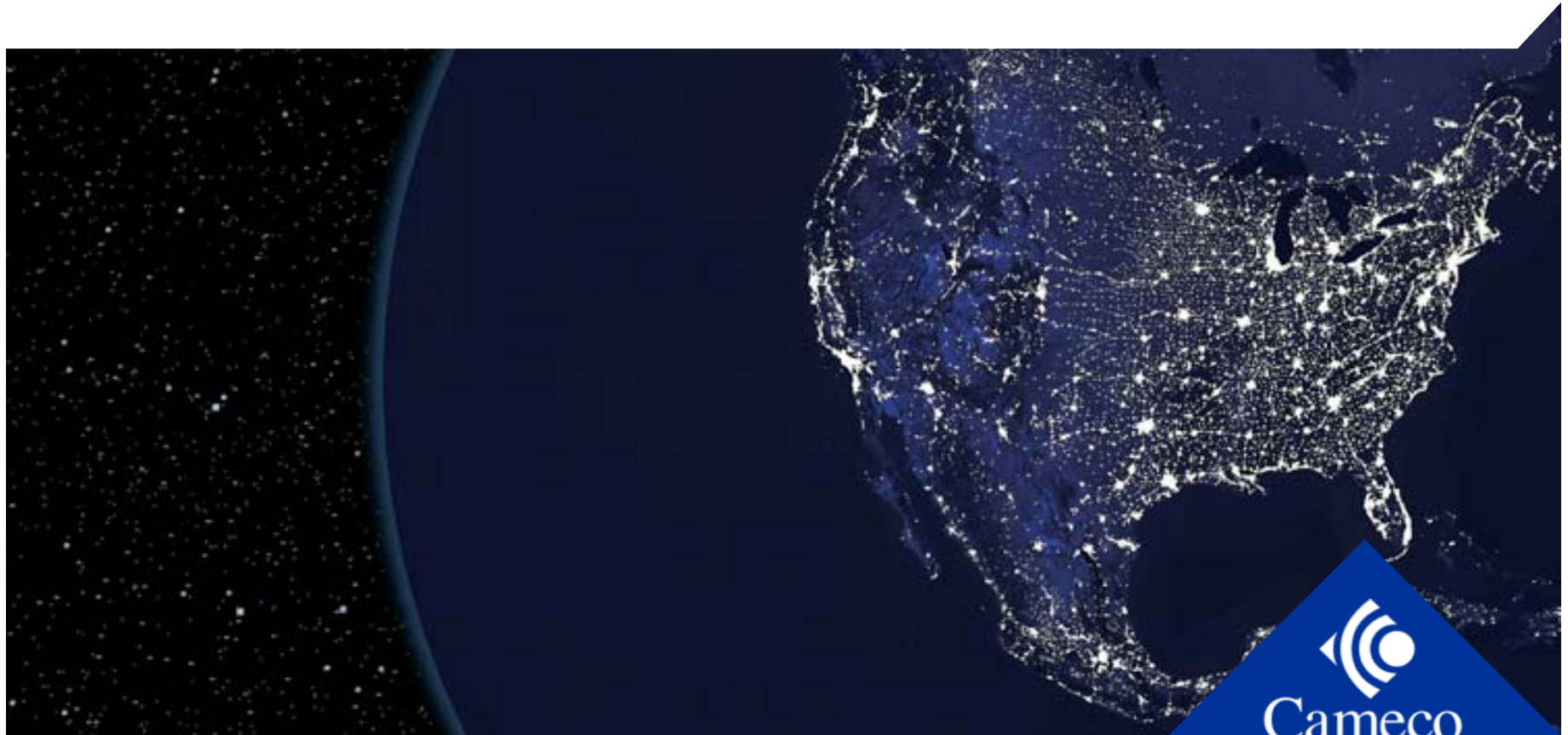


▶ Northern Preferred Supplier Policy
