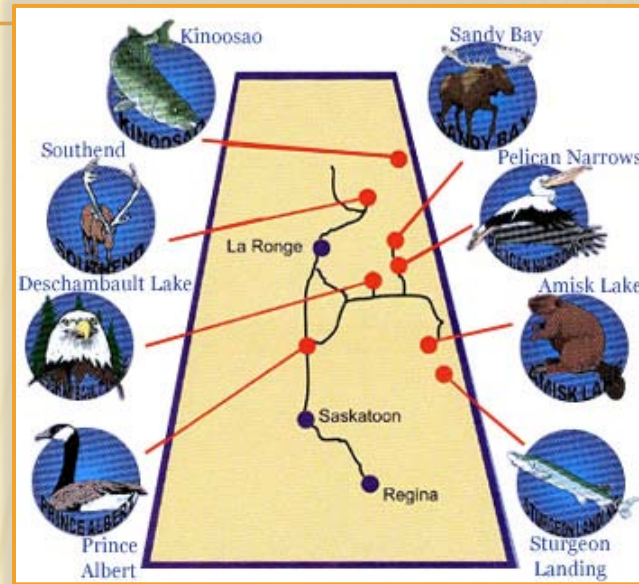

It is our experience that, while permit application and environmental assessment approval decisions are based on technically complete submissions and a reasonably well defined process, significant cost and scheduling advantages can be achieved by the early development and implementation of a sound “approval strategy”.



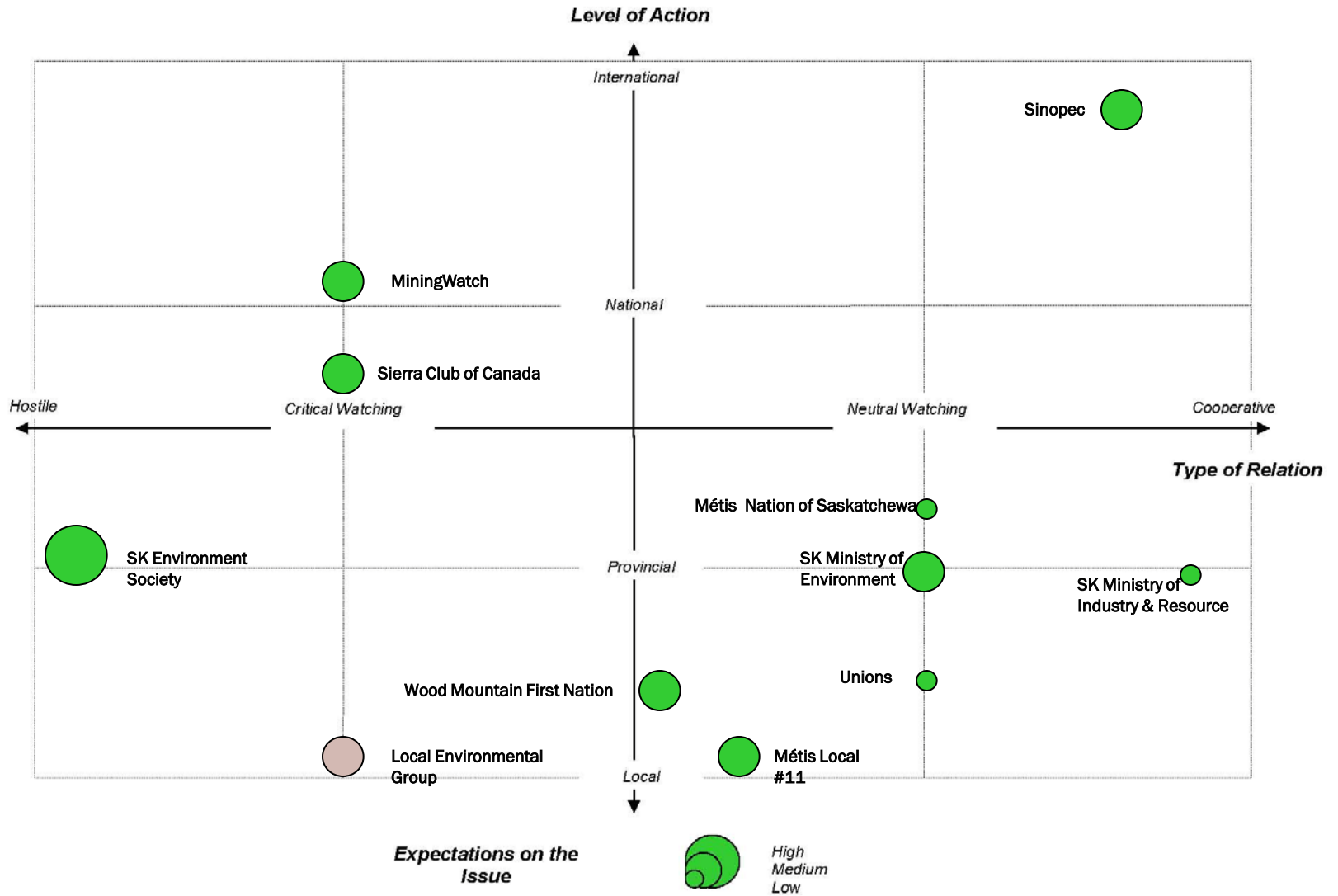
A sound “approval strategy”;

- ✘ Identifies ways and means to minimize identified risks, avoid delays in completing the permit application or environmental assessment process and receiving the requisite approvals;
- ✘ Focuses only on the acquisition of baseline data that is relevant and required; and,
- ✘ Identifies target audiences and appropriate “messaging” to facilitate effective consultations.



Stakeholder Mapping is a formal, interactive process that ASKI uses:

- + To identify all potential project stakeholders (partners, supporters, potential opponents, environmental non-Government organizations, First Nation/Métis organizations, etc.); and,
- + Characterize each of the stakeholders in terms of their potential support or opposition to the proposed project and assess the significance of that support or opposition.





A separate map is developed for the Projects:

- + Environmental issues;
- + Social and economic environment; as well as,
- + Relevant First Nations and Métis "Traditional Pursuits"

Because of our experience and background, the entire mapping exercise takes less than one day regardless of the size of the project.



Effective “**stakeholder mapping**” allows the development of an effective communication and consultation strategy designed to secure a positive “social license” for your project.

This is done by maximizing the value of your projects supporters and effectively addressing its opponents.



BASELINE DATA ACQUISITION

We also believe that your project should focus only on the acquisition of baseline data that is relevant and required.

It should not be an exercise in studying and sampling anything and everything in the project area.



Strategic advantages and cost savings can be realized by the careful consideration of the “how”, “who”, “when” and “content” of your baseline data acquisition program.

- ✘ Prepare draft project focused **Requests for Proposals** for your review and issuance;
- ✘ Manage the baseline data acquisition activities; and,

In terms of effective community consultations, we will;

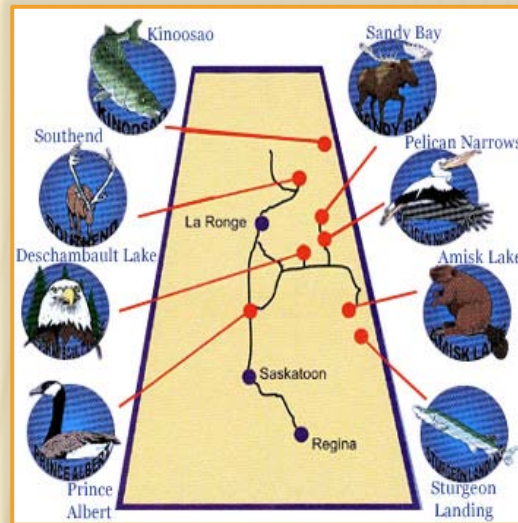
- ✘ Identify appropriate stakeholders and locations for the required consultations.
